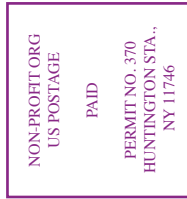
#### Burton Silverman

Burton Silverman is one of America's foremost portrait painters. Whether working in oil, watercolor or pastel, he has concentrated on, as he puts it, "the landscape of the human face". He has completed countless commissions of notable patrons and has had thirty-one solo shows in major cities across the country. His work has appeared in national and international exhibitions, including the National Portrait Gallery, the National Academy Museum, the Butler Institute of American Art, the Mexico City Museum of Art and the Royal Academy of Art in London, garnering numerous prizes along the way, among them the Ranger Purchase Award at the National Academy, twice—in 1965 and 1983.

His paintings are represented in nearly two dozen public collections, including the Brooklyn Museum, the Philadelphia Museum of Art, the Denver Art Museum, the Mint Museum, the Delaware Museum, the New Britain Museum of American Art and the Smithsonian's National Museum of American Art and National Portrait Gallery, as well as private collections in both the U.S. and Europe.

## EXHIBITION OVERVIEW

Definition: Portraiture, the art of representing the physical or psychological likeness of a real or imaginary individual. The principal portrait media are painting, drawing, sculpture and photography. From early times, the portrait has been considered a means to immortality. Many cultures have attributed magical properties to the portrait: symbolization of the majesty or authority of the subject, substitution for a deceased individual's living presence or theft of the soul of the living subject.

## ELIGIBILITY

- Open to artists residing in New Jersey, Connecticut, and New York, including Long Island.
- Artists may enter up to two works, only ONE of which may be accepted.
- Two- and three-dimensional work may be submitted in any medium including photography.
- Work must be original. No giclees or reproductions. We reserve the right to reject on delivery work of questionable facture.
- Work exhibited previously at the Jeanie Tengelsen Gallery is not eligible.

## SPECIFICATIONS

- 2-D work may not exceed 42" in height and 38" in width, INCLUDING FRAME, and 35 lbs in weight.
- 3-D work may not exceed 15" wide by 15" deep by 30" high and 40 lbs in weight.
- 2-D work must be wired tightly. Stretched canvas, if unframed, must have staple-free edges. White or off-white matting only, and no sawtooth hangers. ALLI will not accept work that is damaged or does not meet the specified conditions.

## SUBMISSION OF WORK

- CDs only will be accepted.
- Digital images must be in JPEG form, 300 dpi, 1800 pixels x 1200 pixels, on one CD. File names must be labeled as follows: "LastName\_FirstInitial\_Number\_Title.jpg" Example: Smith\_D\_2\_Babydoll.jpg (Number refers to entry 1 or 2.) Label CD case with artist's name in black marker. CDs will not be returned.

Deadline for receipt of application is April 2. Mail application form, CD, self-addressed, stamped envelope and your non-refundable entry fee to:

Accepted art work must be delivered unwrapped to the Art League on Tues., May 15, from 3 - 8 pm. Out-of-town entries: The UPS Store at 1 Hewitt Square, East Northport, NY 11731 (631-754-4400) will receive your work, unpack it, deliver it to the Art League, and pick up at end of show. Call them for fee and size options.  
No Fed Ex deliveries accepted. ALLI has neither the staff or space to handle packing materials and repack.

## PRIZES & SALES

- Cash awards will be given at the discretion of the judge.
- The Art League will take a 30% commission on all sales.

## LIABILITY

- Entries will be handled with professional care. However the Art League will not be held liable for loss or damage to work.
- We reserve the right to photograph work for publicity purposes.
- Submission of work to this exhibit constitutes an agreement by the artist to the listed terms and conditions.
