PhotoShop for Teachers: Teaching Digital Art

Enjoy learning how to teach your students to use PhotoShop's state-of-the-art tools by completing your own series of creative mini-projects. Use the brush tool to apply painting-style effects to images; explore the filter gallery to combine a variety of special effects in photos; use layers and layer masks to merge two or more photos into a single composition; also covered are the posterizing and coloring tools, text effects to incorporate text into photos in unique ways; and the liquefying tool to create surreal photo images. *Bring a bag lunch!*
